### HEALING (BEGINNING)

\*\*\**A Powerful Joy* by The Rev. Joseph Acton

This small book is filled with deep wisdom about the healing ministry. The author's years of experience and his rich understanding of the essence of the Christian healing ministry are evident in the pages of the book. It is a joy to read it and feel God's desire to heal and transform our lives.

\*\*\**God's Healing River* by Rev. Jack Sheffield

A powerful book inviting people to jump into the river of God's healing and get swept away by the awesome power of his love. It awakens for us the transforming energy of the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

*Healing* by Francis MacNutt

\*\*\**Greater Things Than These – Practicing What Jesus Preached* by Jan de Chambrier

Will encourage and inspire as you witness real-life, modern-day miracles that testify to the power of Jesus at work in and through the body of Christ today.

*How to Pray for the Release of the Holy Spirit* by Dennis Bennett

A small book on how to open ourselves to the full power of God's Spirit for healing ministry.

*Intimacy with God* by Thomas Keating

This is an excellent book on spirituality. It offers numerous methods to experience God in a personal way. It speaks of many ways to allow God's presence to heal our inner hurts and free us from the things which keep us from feeling his deep love for us.

*Life of the Beloved* by Henri Nouwen

This book rings with the affirmation that everyone is loved by God and can enjoy "the life of the beloved." It reveals the wonders of the spiritual journey and renews the fire of faith as much for the prayer minister as for the prayer recipient.

\*\*\**Night Light: Reflections on the Light of Christ in the Night Seasons* by The Rev. Joseph Acton

This book contains personal reflections meant to comfort and encourage the reader. The reflections are especially focused on how the Light of Christ shines in the 'darker' circumstances of life that seem hopeless, frustrating and meaningless. It is helpful in making us sensitive to the light of Christ in the majestic and the mundane moments of our daily lives; empowering us to offer hope and light to others.

## HEALING (MOVING FORWARD)

*Finding Victory When Healing Doesn't Happen* by Randy Clark and Craig Miller

This book offers clear strategies to break through hindrances to healing. It teaches how to find power and authority in Jesus and to pray victoriously against unbelief, fear, curses, spiritual warfare, unforgiveness and more.

*Grace Outpouring: Becoming a People of Blessing* by Roy Godwin

This book captivates the reader through the Spirit-filled story of how speaking blessing prayers releases God's blessings in the lives of God's people, and how those blessings are healing and transforming.

*Healing Generational Wounds* by Doug Schoeninger and Judith Shelly

This important book provides an intercessory prayer process for healing and freeing families, or organizations and communities from wounds and burdens passed generation to generation. It explains specifically how to proceed and at the same time provide a biblical foundation and understanding of the need for generational healing in our lives.

*I Give You Authority* by Charles Kraft

With incredible insight, respected scholar and teacher Dr. Charles Kraft helps awaken you to the extraordinary authority you have been given through the Holy Spirit – the same Spirit who empowered Jesus.

*Inner Healing* by Mike Flynn

*Psychology, Medicine and Christian Healing* by Morton Kelsey

A comprehensive study of how Jesus healed and how his ministry changed through history. It is a classic work on the history of Christian healing affirming how important it is to the life of the church.

*Rediscovering the Ministry of Blessing* by Russ Parker

He writes, “The invasion of God into impossible situations comes through a people who have received power from on high and learn to release it into the circumstances of life.”

*Strengthen Yourself in the Lord* by Bill Johnson

The author offers important ways to keep ourselves energized for God's ministry. He teaches skills to strengthen ourselves and minister to ourselves in order to stay ready and willing to do whatever God is asking of us. He encourages us to develop fundamental truths in our thinking and nurture our intimacy with God.

*The Purpose Driven Life* by Rick Warren

This book offers 40 daily reflections about why God created you.
